ABSTRACT (ENGLISH VERSION)

This study aims to investigate the perceptions of English-majored students at Nam Can Tho University regarding the use of English-subtitled videos as a tool for vocabulary acquisition. The data were collected from 200 students, with semi-structured interviews conducted with 10 randomly selected participants. The researchers employed a mixed-method research design, utilizing a 21 items questionnaire and semi-structured interviews as data collection tools. The findings reveal that students view subtitled videos as a vibrant, motivating, and effective tool for vocabulary learning, enhancing retention and contextual understanding while reducing anxiety among language majors. However, challenges such as content distraction and other factors were noted. These results highlight the revolutionary potential of integrating English-subtitled videos into EFL curricula, fostering dynamic learning environments and providing valuable insights for educators and future research into innovative vocabulary learning strategies.

ABSTRACT (VIETNAMESE VERSION)

Nghiên cứu này nhằm điều tra nhận thức của sinh viên chuyên ngành tiếng Anh tại Đại học Nam Cần Thơ về việc sử dụng video có phụ đề tiếng Anh như một công cụ hỗ trợ học từ vựng. Dữ liệu được thu thập từ 200 sinh viên chuyên ngành ngôn ngữ, với các cuộc phỏng vấn với 10 sinh viên được chọn ngẫu nhiên. Các nhà nghiên cứu đã sử dụng thiết kế nghiên cứu phương pháp hỗn hợp với bảng câu hỏi gồm 21 câu và phỏng vấn bán cấu trúc làm công cụ thu thập dữ liệu. Kết quả cho thấy sinh viên đánh giá video có phụ đề là một công cụ sống động, tạo động lực và hiệu quả cho việc học từ vựng, giúp cải thiện khả năng ghi nhớ và hiểu ngữ cảnh đồng thời giảm lo âu cho sinh viên chuyên ngành ngôn ngữ. Tuy nhiên, một số khó khăn như sự phân tâm bởi nội dung và các yếu tố khác cũng được ghi nhận. Những phát hiện này nhấn mạnh tiềm năng của việc tích hợp video có phụ đề tiếng Anh vào chương trình giảng dạy cho người học EFL, tạo ra môi trường học tập thoải mái vào nền giáo dục và các nghiên cứu tương lai về các chiến lược học từ vựng này.
